

**I. How is the American Indian Education program funded?**

The White Bear Lake Indian Education Program is partially funded through Title VI of the federal Every Student Succeeds Act. In order to apply for these funds, the district needs to document the number of American Indian students enrolled in White Bear Lake Area Schools. This is done through the Title VI Student Eligibility Certification (506) form (link below).

**II. Who is eligible for services?**

Parents/guardians of American Indian students who are members of a tribe or band or who are descendents of a parent or grandparent who is a member of a tribe or band, are asked to consider completing this form. A completed form makes students eligible to receive services that the Title VI federal funding will provide. Completed forms should be returned to your child's school or directly to:

**III. What is the cost for services?**

The American Indian Education program is a federally and state funded program. Program services are available to all American Indian students enrolled in the program free of charge.

**IV. Location?**

**V. How do I enroll my children in White Bear Lake Indian Education?**

**VI. Why should I fill out a 506 form for my children?**

The Federal Government requires ISD 624 to have on file a signed 506 form for each student eligible student, before funding this program.

**VII. What services are currently available for my children?**

The following are free services offered this year:

- Cultural enrichment classes for families and students
- Academic advocacy - monitoring grades and attendance
- Tutoring for highschool students
- Information for post secondary planning, financial aid and scholarships

Students must be enrolled in the program to participate.
