



**White Bear Lake Area Schools  
School Board Meeting Highlights  
September 24, 2018  
Regular/Special and Work-Study Meeting**

At the September 24, 2018 Regular/Special Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. **Certification of 2018 Pay 2019 Proposed Property Tax Levy.** The School Board approved the maximum for the 2018 Payable 2019 Proposed Property Tax Levy. The school districts will discuss the payable 2019 levy and the current year's budget (fiscal year 2018-19) at the December 11, 2018 board meeting at 7 p.m. and allow the public to speak. The final levy certification will be approved at this same meeting.

At the September 24, 2018 Work-Study Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. **Cultural Liaison Introductions.** Sara Paul introduced our six cultural liaisons and provided a brief overview of our engagement priorities for this year. Liaisons work with students, families, and staff with the goal of increasing student and parent engagement through various programs and activities.
