



**White Bear Lake Area Schools
School Board Meeting Highlights
October 8, 2018
Regular Meeting**

Before the October 8, 2018 Regular School Board meeting, the students were recognized for state- and national-level accomplishments in the Advanced Placement Scholars program.

At the October 8, 2018 Regular Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. **2017-18 World's Best Workforce Annual Report.** Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning Sara Paul was joined by Assessment Coordinator Brian Morris to discuss the academic data that will be submitted as part of the 2017-18 World's Best Workforce Report. In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.11, the school board must publish an annual report on the previous year's plan and hold an annual public meeting to review goals, outcomes and strategies.

2. **First Reading of School Policies.** The School Board reviewed policy addendums and heard first readings of the following policies, as recommended by the Policy Committee and Cabinet:

 - e. Policy 424, License Status
 - f. Policy 505, Distribution of Non-School-Sponsored Materials on School Premises by Students and Employees
 - g. Policy 509, Enrollment of Nonresident Students

At the October 8, 2018 Regular Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were acted upon:

1. **Action on Resolution for Combined Primary Polling Place for 2019 State Primary and State General Election.** The School Board approve the resolution and combine the three polling places (P1, P4, and P6) in the Lino Lakes area for the 2019 State primary and State general election.

2. **Action on Delonais/North Campus Property Quitclaim.** The School Board approve the quitclaim deed prepared by the legal representatives for the Duane P Delonais as Trustee of the Phyllis Delonais Living Trust to deed the N. 33 feet of the S. 66 feet of the E. 189 feet of the SW1/4 of Sec.11, T. 30. R. 22. Ramsey County.
3. **Action on Transportation Contracts.** The School Board approved the extended contracts with Rehbein Transit, Inc and HALO Transportation, LLC..
